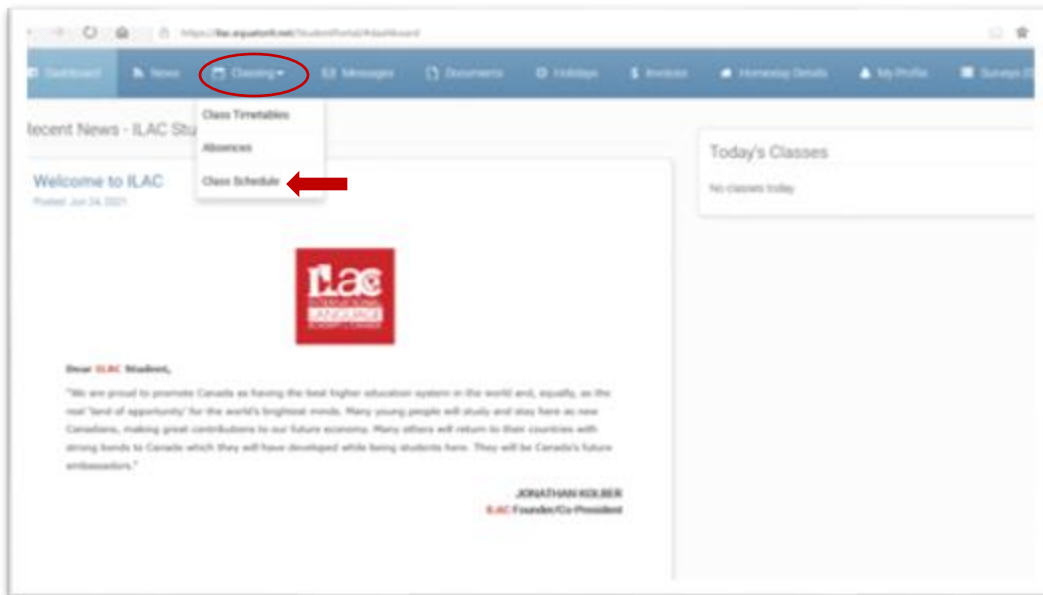

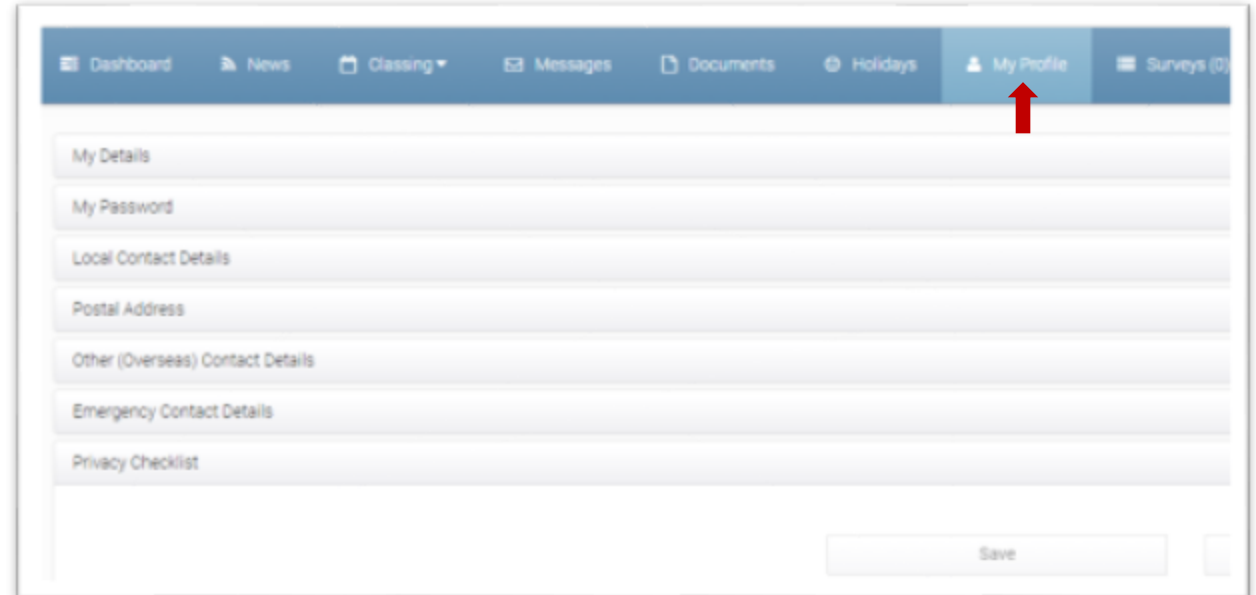

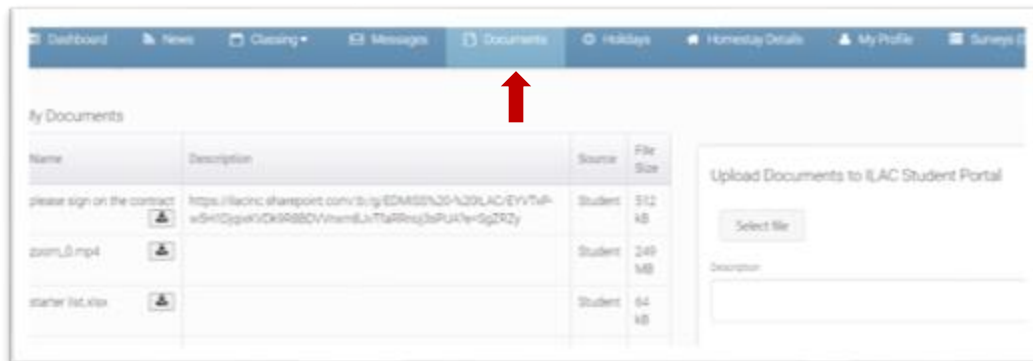
Did you upload your documents?

These documents are required directly from the **Government of Canada** and the **Ministry of Education**.

It is very important to upload your documents to your Student Portal.

Upload Documents to your Student Portal



What documents must you upload?

1. **Study Permit** or **ETA** (Electronic Travel Authorization: the email or a screenshot of the confirmation);
2. **Passport** (the page with your photo, the passport number, and dates of expiry/issue);
3. **Local (Canadian) address** and **phone number**;
4. **Emergency contact** with full name, address, and phone number (parent, spouse, friend, relative – they don't have to be in Canada)
5. **Overseas address and phone number** (if you do not have one, a parent, spouse, friend, or relative's address outside of Canada).

Students must sign enrollment contract.
